- Federal Income Tax Forms, and if applicable, Schedule K-1 (Form 1065)
- W-2 Forms
- Personal Identification Numbers (PINs)
- Student driver's license number
- Social Security numbers
- Student Alien Registration Number for eligible non-citizens
- Date parents were married, separated, divorced, or widowed
- Date of birth for student and parents
- Current cash and checking/savings account balances
- Value of non-retirement investments
- Business or investment farm value
- Child support paid or received
- Workers' compensation benefits
- Housing/food/living allowances for military and clergy
- Veteran's noneducation benefits
