STEP 4 **Put your hands on some Cash.**

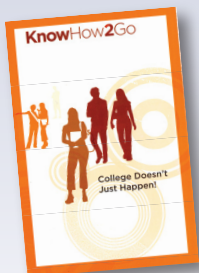
Apply for scholarships and financial aid.

“nada, zip, zilch” bookmark sample – students can use this bookmark to encourage an adult to help them through the college-planning process.

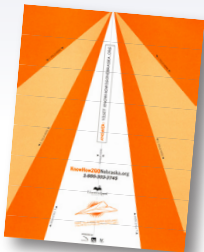


Small KnowHow2GO brochure sample – Department of Education brochure that explains how “college doesn’t just happen.” (Available in Spanish)
