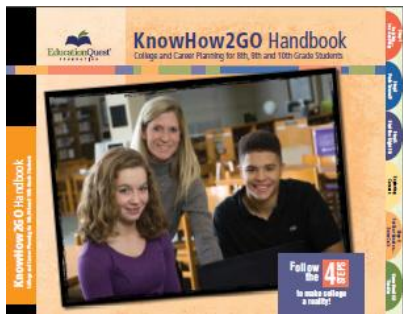

This bookmark includes a “tear-off” that students can give to an adult asking for their help with college planning.

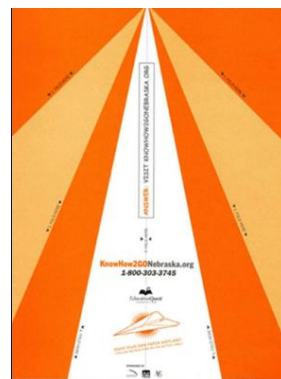
Rubber Wristbands

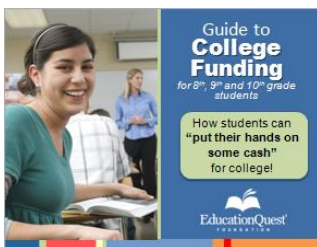

This presentation will help your 8th, 9th and 10th grade students understand what they can do now to earn future scholarships.



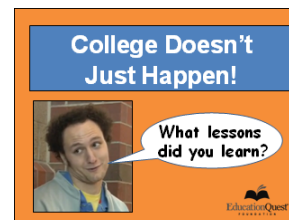

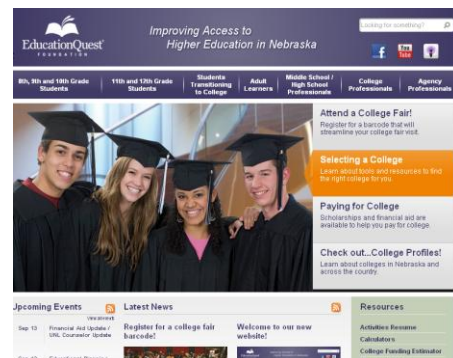
